

Who is eligible to apply for scholarships?

Members of the North Carolina National Guard Association and the spouses, children, grandchildren and legal dependents of active, retired or deceased members are eligible to apply.

What are the scholarship amounts?

Scholarship amounts are currently \$350, \$750 and \$950.

How many scholarships are awarded?

Funds available for scholarships vary from year to year depending on the success of the previous year's fund-raising and contributions. Obviously, the more money raised, the more scholarships the Foundation can award.

What is the duration of the scholarship award?

The Foundation's scholarships are one-year awards. Recipients may reapply by requesting and completing a new application. New applications are not automatically sent to current recipients.

When and how can I get an application?

Applications are available in November. You may pick up an application at your National Guard unit or call 919-851-3390, ext. 5 in the Raleigh calling area or 1-800-821-6159 elsewhere in NC.

Can I use last year's application?

Applications became generic in November, 2001, so you should submit the new one this year. It is green with a yellow insert, or you can download it from the NCNGA website (NCNGA.org)

What is the deadline for applying?

Applications are accepted January 1 to February 1 from college students and high school graduates. High school seniors must submit their applications between February 1 and March 1. Applications must be postmarked by the last due date shown in each category.

When will I find out if I have received a scholarship?

All applicants will be notified by June of the Scholarship Selection Committee's decision.
